All workshops are taught by industry professionals working in their areas of specialism.

Overview:

Digital Film Skills is a specialist, free training scheme for new entrants from diverse, under-represented groups, seeking to work in craft and technical areas of the film industry as camera assistants and assistant editors. With a mixture of theory and practice, it will provide intensive, hands-on experience in digital technologies in camera and post-production. Training is followed by one-to-one support for each participant.

There are 20 places, offered free to London-based participants who can provide evidence of unemployed or very low-waged status. People from diverse backgrounds are particularly encouraged to apply. This programme is aimed at new entrants with a maximum of 1-2 years industry experience.

Please note: We ask when filling out your application that you consider your specialism, and choose either Camera training **OR** Editing training.

Places will be allocated by application and interview.
